## Special Congregational Meetings February 26<sup>th</sup> after 8:00 AM & 10:30 Services

The Congregation Council is calling special congregational meetings for Sunday, February 26<sup>th</sup> at the conclusion of the 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM services for the purpose of voting on a candidate to be called to the position of Director of Youth and Family Ministry at St. Paul's Lutheran Church.

The Director of Youth and Family Ministry will be responsible for leading and overseeing the development, planning, preparation, implementation, coordination and evaluation of all Christian Education programs and ministries for children, youth, adults and families in the church with an emphasis on service, education, fellowship, worship, prayer and outreach.

This position is similar, but not identical to the responsibilities carried out by Marlane Druckenmiller before her retirement.

The candidate for the position is a rostered professional in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America which means she holds a Seminary Masters of Religion degree (In this case from the Lutheran Theological Seminary at Philadelphia) and is under call and in good standing on the Ministry Roster of the ELCA. Therefore, as was the case with Marlane, her position would be a "called" position.

Biographical information about the candidate will be distributed before the meetings and there will be an opportunity to meet the candidate and ask questions between services during a social time. Therefore, if having an opportunity to meet and talk to the candidate is important to you before you vote, you should plan to vote at the meeting after the 10:30 AM service.

It is very important that all members of the congregation plan to be present and participate in this call process and take an opportunity to meet the candidate for this important ministry in the life of St. Paul's Lutheran Church. Also, please pray for God's guidance for yourself and our congregation as we seek to discern God's will for our ministry on behalf of Christ.
